


CIVIL ENGINEERS OF THE YEAR - CALL FOR AWARDS NOMINATIONS

Scoring for the award will be based on the categories listed under the eligibility and judging criteria for each award. CIVIL ENGINEERS OF THE YEAR - ELIGIBILITY AND JUDGING CRITERIA

CENTRAL ILLINOIS CIVIL ENGINEER OF THE YEAR AWARD:

This award was established to recognize distinguished civil engineers for significant engineering contributions.

I. The award may be given annually to an engineer of recognized standing, who:

- Must be a licensed professional engineer
- Are presently employed as an engineer
- Practice within one of the counties of the Central Illinois Section
- Have a minimum of fifteen years of service as a civil engineer, with five of the fifteen years at the senior administrative level
- **II.** Qualifications of the award nominees will be judged on the following:
 - Sustained outstanding civil engineering performance
 - Evidence of high character and professional integrity
 - Civic and humanitarian activities (community service)

Engineering achievements	50 points
Educational achievements	10 points
Continuing professional development (last five years)	10 points
Professional/technical society activities	10 points
Awards/honors	10 points
Civic and humanitarian activities	10 points
TOTAL	100 Points

III. Names of candidates considered by the Awards Committee but not selected will be reconsidered the following year. Individuals must be renominated after two years.



CENTRAL ILLINOIS GOVERNMENT CIVIL ENGINEER OF THE YEAR AWARD:

This award was established to recognize distinguished civil engineers employed in public service for significant engineering contributions as a practitioner in public service.

I. The award may be given annually to an engineer of recognized standing, who:

- Must be a licensed professional engineer
- Are presently employed as an engineer in the U.S. public sector
- Practice within one of the counties of the Central Illinois Section
- Have a minimum of fifteen years of public service as a civil engineer, with five of the fifteen years at the senior administrative level

II. Qualifications of the award nominees will be judged on the following:

- Sustained outstanding civil engineering performance in the public sector
- Evidence of high character and professional integrity
- Civic and humanitarian activities (community service)

Educational achievements	10 points
Continuing professional development (last five years)	10 points
Professional/technical society activities	10 points
Awards/honors	10 points
Civic and humanitarian activities	10 points
TOTAL	100 Points

III. Names of candidates considered by the Awards Committee but not selected will be reconsidered the following year. Individuals must be renominated after two years.



CENTRAL ILLINOIS YOUNG CIVIL ENGINEER OF THE YEAR AWARD:

This award was established to recognize distinguished young civil engineers for demonstrated leadership potential and significant engineering contributions.

- **I.** The award may be given annually to an engineer of recognized standing, who:
 - Must be age thirty-five years or less on January 1 of the year the award is presented
 - Have at least five (5) years of professional work experience in the engineering profession
 - Are presently employed as an engineer
 - Practice within one of the counties of the Central Illinois Section
 - Must be a licensed professional engineer (PE) or engineer intern (EI)
- **II.** Qualifications of the award nominees will be judged on the following:
 - Excellent performance that has demonstrated leadership potential in civil engineering
 - Contributions to ASCE society activities
 - Evidence of high character and professional integrity
 - Civic and humanitarian activities (community service)

Professional/technical society activities	30 points
Engineering achievements	20 points
Civic and humanitarian activities	15 points
Continuing professional development (last three years)	10 points
Awards/honors	10 points
Professional Licensure	10 points
Education	5 points
TOTAL	100 Points
