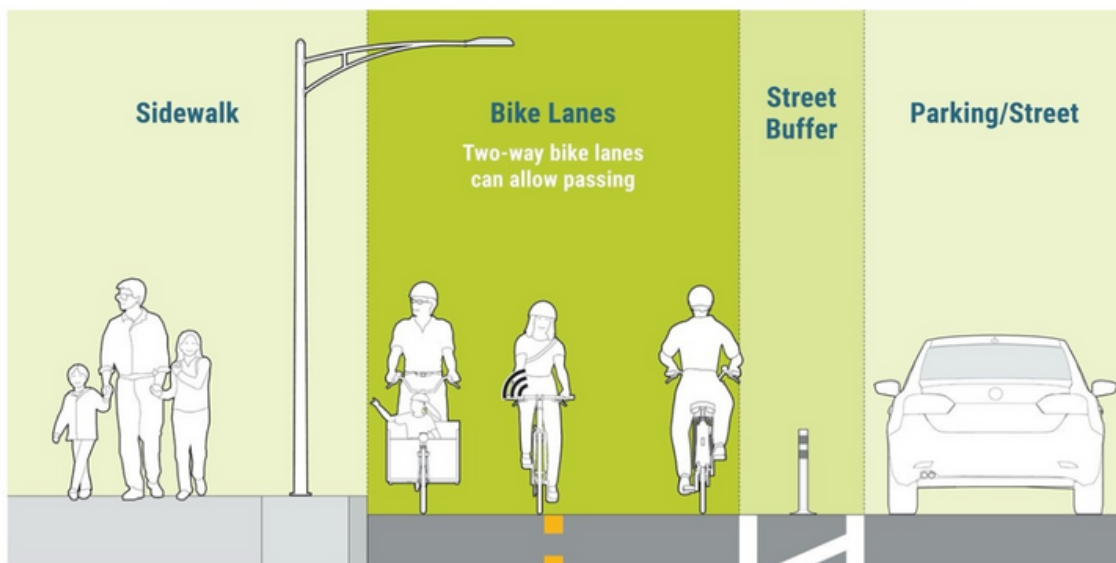

MAY 17, 2023 CSCE VIRTUAL LUNCH MEETING 12:00 PM EARN 1 NYS PDH SAVING THE WORLD, ONE PROTECTED BIKE LANE AT A TIME Patricia Houser, Ph.D., AICP, CCSU

Protected bike lanes are now recognized as *essential infrastructure for the future* in analyses from urban planning organizations (including the Urban Institute, and Planetizen) and groups like the Institute for Transportation and Development Policy (ITDP), National Association of City Transportation Officials (NAACTO), and the National Transportation Safety Board. This talk summarizes peer reviewed literature, as recent as 2023, pointing to the impacts of different bicycle lane designs, on economics, health and environment, and the role of active transportation in overall urban design, and makes a case for infrastructure redesign as the key to enjoying the world-changing benefits of the lowly bicycle.

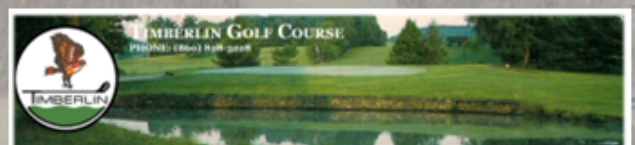

About CSCE

The CSCE is the result of a merger of two organizations that occurred over 40 years ago. The Connecticut Society of Civil Engineers was founded in 1884, while the Connecticut Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers was founded in 1919. In 1958, the Section had 523 members. In 1955 (the nearest comparable year for reliable numbers), the Society had 1,033 members. The two organizations met separately until they merged in 1981, by mutual vote of membership, to become the Connecticut Society of Civil Engineers Section of American Society of Civil Engineers or CSCE.
