Inspects and analyzes existing infrastructure such as floodwalls, levees, revetment, and storm sewers, and prepares findings and recommendations. Assists with capital planning, cost estimates, and budgeting. May complete regulatory permit applications and/or grant applications.

Prepares materials and may represent MCD at various meetings. Provides information and answers questions regarding projects.
