

Proposed Changes to Bylaws of ASCE

(From ASCE website 9-6-04)

A meeting of the ASCE Board of Direction will be held on October 19-20, 2004, in Baltimore, Maryland. Among the items to be considered are amendments to the Society's bylaws. Pursuant to Section 11.1.2 of ASCE's constitution, Society members are required to be notified at least 60 days prior to Board action on such amendments.

The Board has received notice of the following amendments that would alter the bylaws as follows:

Allow the International Activities Committee, rather than the Council of Vice Presidents, to recommend the formation of International Student Groups.

Change Canada and Mexico from being considered domestic with members assigned to Districts and instead make them international territories whose members are considered international

Clarify and make consistent the criteria for advancement to Fellow.

Implement governance restructuring ONLY if the membership approves the proposed Constitutional Amendment on this summer's national election ballot by 2/3 of those members voting in the election.
