ELIGIBILITY:

The successful applicant must be enrolled as a full-time Civil Engineering undergraduate student at a 4-year ABET accredited Mississippi university. The applicant must complete the attached application and submit a one-page essay entitled *"The Civil Engineer's Role in America's Aging Infrastructure; Design and Beyond"*. The essay should discuss a civil engineer's various roles and responsibilities in society with respect to America's Aging Infrastructure.

CRITERIA:

The following criteria will be used to award the scholarships to applicants: academic performance, awards and honors, extracurricular involvement, need, and the written essay. The Mississippi Section awards committee will select the successful applicants following receipt of all applications based on the above deadline.
