## NEW JERSEY SECTION

### STUDENT CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are available for award to members of A.S.C.E. Student Chapters located in the State of New Jersey and members of out of State A.S.C.E. Student Chapters having their legal home address in the State of New Jersey. The Board of Directors of the New Jersey Section of American Society of Civil Engineers established these awards in 1987.

#### I. ELIGIBILITY:

- A) Any third year undergraduate of a four year B.S.C.E. program, or any fourth year undergraduate of a five year B.S.C.E. program who is a member of an A.S.C.E. student chapter may apply for these scholarships without restriction as to academic class standing or marital status, but subject to the requirement that the applicant must be a member in good standing at the time of application and award.
- B) The Scholarships shall be awarded only to a student who will utilize the funds to continue with undergraduate education in Civil Engineering.
- C) Previous winners of these scholarships are not eligible for this award.
- D) No more than three (3) students from any one student chapter may apply for the scholarship awards each year.

#### II APPLICATION: (see enclosed copy)

Applications must be submitted in quadruplicate (original plus 3 copies) to the A.S.C.E. Student Chapter Faculty Advisor. The applications must include:

- 1) Proof of Student Chapter Membership;
- 2) A statement by the applicant of the reasons believed to justify the award;
- 3) The applicant's plans for continuing his/her education and a statement outlining how the applicant will finance his/her education if an award is granted;
- 4) Records of academic performance and standing;

- 5) Statement of appraisal of the applicant in terms of potential for growth, character, leadership capacity and interests from the student chapter Faculty Advisor and at least one other member of the faculty.

The completed application (original plus 3 copies) must be forwarded by the Faculty Advisor to the New Jersey Section Scholarship Committee not later than April 4, 2009 at the following address:

### III. SELECTION:

- A) Two applicants may be selected each year to receive an award.
- B) Selection will be made by the Awards Committee of the New Jersey Section American Society of Civil Engineers. No faculty or N.J. ASCE Contact Member shall serve on this committee.
- C) The Central Branch NJASCE is also offering a \$2000 scholarship. Students submitting the NJ Section scholarship application will automatically receive consideration for the Branch award.

### IV. AWARDS:

- A) The successful applicant (s) will be notified of their selection by the Scholarship Committee chair of the New Jersey Section, American Society of Civil Engineers, on or about May 1 following submittal of the application.
- B) The sum of each scholarship to be awarded for this academic year will be \$2,000.
- C) The awards will be presented during the Annual Awards meeting of the New Jersey Section, American Society of Civil Engineers.
- D) The award shall be deposited to the awardee's account with the business office of the institution attended by the applicant, or other agency (office) so designated by the awardee and approved by the Section, during the fall semester of the awardee's senior year. Withdrawals from such other agency accounts may be made only with concurrence of the Student Chapter Faculty Advisor who shall assure the Section that withdrawals from any accounts established outside the award winner's university account are utilized for educational expenses only.
