#### 1) Previous Minutes

#### c. Volunteer Events Committee Report

1. The Board attended the NDSU ASCE Student Chapter meeting on March 27, 2013 to discuss ideas for a doing a joint project. The chapter came up with an idea to do a "Firm Crawl". This would include having a group of civil engineering students that would go to 4 different engineering companies and learn about what they do. This event would help the student chapter recruit members while also allowing the ND Section members to volunteer their time towards a good event that helps students understand the profession. ## 5) Old Business

## a. Bylaw Updates

- 3. The Secretary recommended making some changes to the election process to more accurately follow what is currently being done. The "Nominating Committee" was removed and would now allow any subscribing member to nominate another member to be included on the ballot, given they have received consent from that member.

## a. Vice President Election
