ASCE PHILADELPHIA SECTION STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

A minimum of one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded by the Section to a civil engineering student who meets the following requirements:

The applicant must be matriculating in a full-time Civil Engineering or Architectural Engineering program at one of the Philadelphia Sections five Student Chapters: Drexel University, Swarthmore College, Temple University, Villanova University, or Widener University.

- The applicant must be an active ASCE Student Member.

Application Requirements:

Cover letter containing:

- The applicant's name
- The applicant's ASCE ID Number
- The applicant's institution
- Degree Level
- Address/telephone number
- Additional information for consideration (such as need, class rank, or GPA)

Resume

Letter of Recommendation from faculty advisor

Essay (limited to 1,000 words) on the following topic:

Protecting the environment is every Civil Engineer's responsibility. Choose your preferred branch of Civil Engineering (Architectural Engineering; Coasts, Oceans, Ports & Rivers; Construction; Engineering Mechanics; Environmental & Water Resources; Geotechnical Engineering; Structural Engineering; Transportation and Development; and Utility Engineering and Surveying) and identify what types of best practices you can implement in your future career. How will you use these best practices to shape your personal design philosophy?

ASCE PHILADELPHIA SECTION SECTION MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

A minimum of one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded by the Section to a civil engineering student who is the child of an active Philadelphia Section member. The requirements are the same as that of the Student Scholarship except:

All children of active Philadelphia Section members matriculated in any full-time Civil Engineering or Architectural Engineering program at an accredited college or university are eligible.

Application requirements and submittal deadline are the same as for the Student Scholarship. The applicant's cover letter should include parents name and ASCE ID number.
