Iowa Machine Shed, Davenport, IA**

Nick will be presenting on the design and operation of the Thornton Transitional Reservoir. The Thornton Transitional Reservoir is located in Thornton, IL, a southern suburb of Chicago. A series of storm water structures were designed that divert Thorn Creek storm water flow to this new reservoir to prevent it from overwhelming the creek and Little Calumet River. The transitional reservoir is the first stage of a massive two-stage project that will provide flood relief to Chicago and its south suburbs. Details of design, construction, and operation of this project and its overall effect on flood control will be given in the presentation.
