Speaker: Patrick E. Mullin, P.E. and Vice President with Stanley Consultants, Inc. in Muscatine specializes in water and wastewater projects. His projects include the Davenport West Side Diversion Tunnel project, which is the topic of this month's program. Pat's career spans 36 years. He graduated from Iowa State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering in 1968 and from the University of Iowa with a Masters Degree in Environmental Engineering in 1978. Pat has completed projects in Iowa, Illinois, throughout the mid-West, and internationally.

Pat is a long time member of the American Society of Civil Engineers. He attained the status of Fellow in 1992.

The Davenport West Side Diversion Tunnel project is part of Davenport's long range plan to improve their existing wastewater collection and treatment system. The West Side Diversion Tunnel is a trunk sewer that will extend adequate sewer service to Northwest Davenport while relieving the existing trunk sewers along Duck Creek. The 60" diameter sewer construction will include an open cut sewer and street replacement through existing industrial and residential development, a major tunnel through the ridge that is between the Mississippi River and Duck Creek, and an open cut sewer through the open field behind Williams Intermediate School then west along Duck Creek to Silver Creek.
