PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION STATE CIVIL ENGINEERING LANDMARK

TENNESSEE SECTION AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CIVIL ENGINEERS

The Tennessee Section of the ASCE has established a History and Heritage Committee for the purpose of recognizing the historical achievements of the profession. The Criteria Listing and Nomination Form provided with this packet may be used to help the Tennessee Section identify Historic Civil Engineering Landmarks which may be worthy of designation in that regard.

Anyone may nominate a project for consideration as a State Civil Engineering Landmark. Reference to the Criteria For Nomination (attached) is invited in this regard.

Nominations must be made using the Nomination Form prepared by the Section History and Heritage Committee. Attachments to the form are encouraged.

All nominations must be received by the History and Heritage Committee by June 1 for consideration during the current year. Designations will be announced at the Annual Section Meeting (normally held in September).
