Tennessee's infrastructure is deteriorating and is in critical need of maintenance and improvement to meet current and future demands. While the condition of Tennessee's roads, bridges and airports exceeds nationwide scores, Tennessee's schools and public park facilities lag behind the rest of the country.



The ASCE Tennessee Section 2009 Infrastructure Report Card is the first comprehensive assessment of the condition of the state's infrastructure. The Report Card presents an informed assessment made by the state's professional engineering community of the condition of the infrastructure critical to our quality of life in Tennessee.

Tennessee's infrastructure received an overall grade of C with individual grades in nine infrastructure categories. This report card offers guidance to Tennesseans and their leaders about where public works funds would be best spent to improve the overall quality of life.
