# 2017 Vermont Stormwater Management Rule has been Approved

On December 28, 2016 the final adopted 2017 rule was filed with the Vermont Secretary of State. The new manual and rules will become effective on July 1, 2017. The Stormwater Program is currently working on repackaging the new rule in an updated format that will include guidance, schematics, and photos to assist in the design process. Training on the new manual is anticipated to be offered in late winter/spring 2017 to support designers (more details to follow as information becomes available)

### **UVM Capstone Design Mentoring Update**

We had strong support from ASCE Vermont practitioners in November and December including both individual project team mentoring and project reviewers for 30% stage review presentations in early December. We are very grateful for that support. The students are eager to get feedback and suggestions from practitioners and the wide breadth of expertise and experience represented in our cadre of practitioners is impressive. Students are continuing on their projects this spring semester with 60% stage review sessions to be held at the end of February/beginning of March 2017. Practitioner opportunities in addition to capstone project mentoring and reviewing include presentations on special topics and presentations to both our seniors and our first year civil and environmental engineering students. 
