- 1. Welcome (Danny Xiao) Danny called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m.
- 2. Consent Agenda (Danny Xiao)
 - a. January 2023 Meeting Minutes (Secretary) Attachment 2a
 - b. Approve Agenda (Danny Xiao)
 Martin requested that the financial report be removed from the consent agenda for discussion.
 Brad moved to approve the consent agenda with the removal of the financial report. Matt seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed; motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Consent Agenda Items Requiring Individual Votes
 - Financial Report (Martin Hanson) Attachment 2b

Marty inquired to the Society as to why allotments have not yet been received and they will not be received until annual reports are filed. The Northwest Branch, Southeast Branch, and Wisconsin Section have not yet filed reports.

Impact will send an email to all members of the northwest and southeast boards with instructions on how to submit their annual report, as well as get the Wisconsin Section annual report ASAP.

Membership: Branch renewals are down 11% as a Section, NW branch is down 37%. There is some concern that membership is starting to lag.

Joe moved to authorize Marty to move forward to select a brokerage with the lowest fees for the Section in an amount not to exceed \$20,000 in securities with maturities no greater than 12 months. Brad seconded the motion. Martin and Brad abstained. Motion passed.

Martin will report the results back to the board and any further recommendations.

Due to time and schedule constraints, Joe requested to be removed as the lead for the public sector efforts of the strategic plan update. Danny relayed that we will find a replacement for this effort. Jennifer H. provided an overview of her written report (attached). Jen has been presenting at the various student chapters the past few months.

Martin made a motion to reimburse Jen up to \$500 for expenses related to strategic plan implementation, based on receipts. Danny seconded the motion. Joe proposed an amendment to the motion to have these funds apply only to task #3 in the strategic plan - so that students benefit from the amendment. The amendment was accepted. All in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.
