#### 2. Review/Approve Minutes from CSCE Meeting on January 17, 2023

• Scott Nolan made a motion to approve the minutes. Brianna Ritacco seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

#### 3. Monthly Dinner Meetings

February 15 - In-Person Dinner Meeting at the Constitution Room in Memorial Hall at CCSU – Registration is open.

March 22 - In-Person Dinner Meeting at the Norwalk Inn - Registration is open.

April 18 - In-Person Dinner Meeting at the USCGA - Registration is open and CSCE still needs a speaker bio, a presentation overview and photos to promote the meeting. CSCE also needs to finalize the schedule for the meeting, which will include the distribution of student awards.

### 4. Annual Events / Critical Discussion Items:

- 4.1 Younger Members Group Update Tom Wamser shared the following info:
  - Social on January 26, 2023 This event went well. The YMG may host another social in about 6 months.
  - Resume Review at UNH on February 14, 2023 There are 4-5 volunteers who have signed up and potentially 30 students could attend. More volunteer resume reviewers are always welcome. Food will be provided.
  - The Yard Goats contacted him about a group trip to the stadium.
  - United Concrete in Wallingford connected with Eric Hoyt and Tom Wamser to host a visit to a site. Tom Loto also went on a similar site visit recently that was well attended.

### 4.2 ACE Awards - May 23, 2023

- The deadline is March 17, 2023.
- Registration/Sponsorship Rates Tyler Parker will review past costs at the ACE Awards before recommending any
  price changes for this year.
- 2024 CSCE can reserve the Glass Room now for the 2024 ACE Awards to avoid conflicting with other organizations' events in May/June. In January 2023, the Aqua Turf had these dates available in 2024: May 6, 7, 8, 13, 14, and 15. After discussing the different dates, it was decided that Amy Petrone will ask the Aqua Turf Club about reserving the Glass Room on May 15 and if that is not available, then she will ask about May 14, 8 and 7.
- 4.3 PayPal Update The Board discussed looking into other payment processing options. Aaron Foster shared that Constant Contact is being replaced nationally at ASCE National. State sections will get a subscription to the new registration processor from ASCE for free. This change is expected to happen in September 2023. CSCE will wait until after that change is made to make any changes with its PayPal account.

## 5.1 President's Report:

- Scott Nolan will reach out to current CSCE Board Members about being on the Board in 2023-24. If anyone has

- Scott Nolan will reach out to Brianna Ritacco to find out if CSCE can give out PDHs for speakers at seminars and dinner meetings.

# 5.2 President-Elect's Report:

- Aaron Foster provided the following information from the 2023 ERYMC Joe Natale of the ASCE Philadelphia Section created a PDH certificate generator that CSCE can use. Also, CSCE dinner meetings are unique and other sections are interested in running similar events.

- The balances from Webster Accounts & PayPal are ~\$4,000 in Savings, ~\$4,000 in Checking, and ~\$13,000 in PayPal.
- The Board discussed some challenges with CSCE finances. CSCE needs to look at the sponsorship levels for 2023. Scott Nolan, George Gerard and Aaron Foster can meet with him about CSCE's finances and ways to generate revenue.
- Anyone with expenses from the 2022 ERYMC should submit them to Tyler Parker.
- One way to raise money is to raise CSCE Section dues.
- Amy Petrone will gather information about past costs at dinner meetings. Aaron Foster and Tyler Parker will review them and determine any changes in the future.
- After a discussion about the rising costs of dinner meetings and their effect on CSCE's finances, Scott Nolan made
  a motion to increase all the registration costs of the upcoming meetings in March and April by \$10 (except for
  speakers). Rich Cohen seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Tom Loto suggested that CSCE look at offering annual sponsorships to companies.
- CSCE could also change sponsorship levels at monthly meetings, i.e., offer a recruitment sponsor level and reduce the \$1,000 sponsorship to a more affordable amount.
