Eligibility: To be considered for this scholarship:

1. Applicant must be an incoming freshman currently accepted in a college, university, or technical school, in a civil/environmental engineering or construction related program. Preference shall be given to applicants who are members or student members of CSCE/ASCE or have parents or relatives who are members of CSCE/ASCE.

Requirements:

- 1. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that the CSCE Administrative Assistant, **prior to March 15, 2025** (or as noted on the CSCE website), receives all of the following items.
 - Completed application form.
 - Proof of enrollment and/or acceptance into a civil/environmental engineering or construction related program at a college, university or technical school
 - One or two reference letters. Reference(s) cannot be a relative of the individual applying.
 - Unofficial transcript of high school or technical school.
 - Short Essay from applicant entitled, "Why I Should Receive the CSCE Student Scholarship." See Section V on the application form for more details.

Awards:

- CSCE will determine the number and dollar amount of awards. The minimum award will be \$500.
- 2. CSCE will review all applications considering each applicant's interest in engineering or construction by reviewing the grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience and essay.
- 3. Scholarship funds will be distributed to the recipients as a one-time (lump sum) payment to be applied to expenses related to pursuing higher education.
- 4. All scholarship recipients will be announced on or near April 1st of each year (or as revised on the CSCE website).
