### Eligibility: To be considered for this scholarship:

1. Applicant must be an incoming freshman currently accepted in a college, university, or technical school, in a civil/environmental engineering or construction related program. Preference shall be given to applicants who are members or student members of CSCE/ASCE or have parents or relatives who are members of CSCE/ASCE.

### Requirements:

1. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that the CSCE Administrative Assistant, **prior to March 15, 2026** (or as noted on the CSCE website), receives all of the following items.
  - Completed application form.
  - Proof of enrollment and/or acceptance into a civil/environmental engineering or construction related program at a college, university or technical school
  - One or two reference letters. Reference(s) cannot be a relative of the individual applying.
  - Unofficial transcript of high school or technical school.
  - Short Essay from applicant entitled, "Why I Should Receive the CSCE Student Scholarship." See Section V on the application form for more details.

### Awards:

1. CSCE will determine the number and dollar amount of awards. The minimum award will be \$500.
2. CSCE will review all applications considering each applicant's interest in engineering or construction by reviewing the grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience and essay.
3. Scholarship funds will be distributed to the recipients as a one-time (lump sum) payment to be applied to expenses related to pursuing higher education.
4. All scholarship recipients will be announced on or near April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year (or as revised on the CSCE website) and invited to the CSCE Dinner Meeting at the U.S. Coast Guard Academy in New London, CT, on April 14, 2026, to receive the scholarship in person.
