

# Please join us for a Unique Presentation at the Canal Park Barr Office October 17, 2023 at 12:00 pm



"Removing contaminants (mercury and sulfur) from municipal industrial wastewater" Presented by Nate Johnson

Dr. Johnson and his university collaborators have been working with State of MN and industrial partners to understand better methods to remove mercury from municipal wastewater and sulfur from industrial wastewater. Detailed sampling at 15 municipal wastewater plants and an analysis of tens of thousands of historical observations have shown that tertiary filters - both membranes and granular media - do an excellent job of removing mercury to even very low Great Lakes limits.


