#### Presentation: Aquipor Technologies Kevin Kunz

#### Date: Thursday, September 17th, 2020 Time: Noon – 1 PM

AquiPor is a startup company that is developing large-scale onsite stormwater solutions starting with a new type of pavement-like material that allows rainfall / stormwater to flow through it into the ground below, but unlike existing permeable pavements, is resistant to clogging due to the material's pore size.

Aquipor is developing their technology to be a lower cost, lower maintenance, and smaller footprint solution for on-site stormwater management. At scale this can mean using Aquipor's solutions in lieu of space-consuming swales, stormwater ponds, and helping offset the cost and footprint of subterranean "grey" infrastructure.
