Virtual seminar:

- Sam Wilke: sent out the flyer to board members. Beena suggested that ND ASCE should be the hosts and should be highlighted on the flyer.
- Yaping suggested that we should include a phrase Virtual seminar series – ND ASCE to suggest that we may have more seminars in the future.
- Registration costs (free to our members, students, fee for non-members). Collecting money in zoom is a possibility.
- 1-PDH for this seminar and using Zoom for the seminar is a good option. However, the maximum participation is capped at 300 members.
- After debating the price, the rate was fixed as \$15. This money can be collected through Zoom, Eventbrite, or ND ASCE website
- Let us advertise that we have limited spots. The flyer should be modified to include the pdh information, ASCE logo, and zoom link.
- Beena – collect money through Zoom. Alexa – our website could be a good option. As the website is maintained by the National ASCE, we may have to pay a fee to them.
- Potential future speakers: Yaping Chi – 5 members added as potential speakers. 5 speakers available. We can schedule a COVID ppt in the month of February. Yaping Chi – will invite Dr. Lin from NDSU to talk about detecting COVID from waste water.
