ASCE PHILADELPHIA SECTION MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

A minimum of one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded by the Section to a civil engineering student who is the child of an active Philadelphia Section member. All children of active Philadelphia Section members matriculated in any full-time Civil Engineering or Architectural Engineering program at an accredited college or university are eligible.

Application Requirements:

- Cover letter containing:
 - The applicant's name
 - The applicant's ASCE ID Number as well as their parent's name and ASCE ID number
 - The applicant's institution
 - Degree Level
 - Address/telephone number
 - Additional information for consideration (such as need, class rank, or GPA)
- Resume
- Letter of recommendation from faculty advisor
- Essay (limited to 1,000 words) on the following topic: *The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) is a United States federal statute signed on November 15th, 2021. This act includes approximately \$1.2 trillion in spending that included provisions related to federal-aid highway, transit, highway safety, motor carrier, research, hazardous materials, rail programs and more. What impact will infrastructure packages like these have on the civil engineering profession? And how will we, as a profession, adapt to this influx of funding?*

Submittal Deadline:
