



2023 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Section offers two distinct scholarships annually:

1. ASCE Philadelphia Section Student Scholarship
2. ASCE Philadelphia Section Member Scholarship

All scholarship winners will be recognized as the Section's guests at our annual Spring Social.

ASCE PHILADELPHIA SECTION STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

A minimum of one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded by the Section to a civil engineering student who meets the following requirements:

The applicant must be matriculating in a full-time Civil Engineering or Architectural Engineering program at one of the Philadelphia Sections five Student Chapters: Drexel University, Swarthmore College, Temple University, Villanova University, or Widener University.

- The applicant must be an active ASCE Student Member.

Application Requirements:

- Cover letter containing:
 - The applicant's name
 - The applicant's ASCE ID Number
 - The applicant's institution
 - Degree Level
 - Address/telephone number
 - Additional information for consideration (such as need, class rank, or GPA)
- Resume
- Letter of recommendation from faculty advisor
- Essay (limited to 1,000 words) on the following topic: *The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) is a United States federal statute signed on November 15th, 2021. This act includes approximately \$1.2 trillion in spending that included provisions related to federal-aid highway, transit, highway safety, motor carrier, research, hazardous materials, rail programs and more. What impact will infrastructure packages like these have on the civil engineering profession? And how will we, as a profession, adapt to this influx of funding?*

Submittal Deadline:

Applications (**including recommendations**) must be submitted by **Friday, March 31st, 2023** to Scholarship Committee Chair, Dani Schroeder (dani.civileng@gmail.com).

ASCE PHILADELPHIA SECTION MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

A minimum of one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded by the Section to a civil engineering student who is the child of an active Philadelphia Section member. The requirements are the same as that of the Student Scholarship except:

All children of active Philadelphia Section members matriculated in any full-time Civil Engineering or Architectural Engineering program at an accredited college or university are eligible.

Application requirements and submittal deadline are the same as for the ASCE Philadelphia Section Student Scholarship. In addition, the applicant's cover letter should include parents name and ASCE ID number.
