#### ASCE Region 9 launches the California Infrastructure Card update!

ASCE Region 9 has initiated updating the California Infrastructure Report Card and we are looking for professionals from all 4 sections (Los Angeles, San Francisco, San Diego, and Sacramento), interested in this opportunity.

#### The Task

The California Infrastructure Report Card was last updated in 2012, and included 8 categories. The new Report Card will be expanded to 17 infrastructure categories, for consistency with the ASCE 2017 National Infrastructure Report Card, and has a planned release date of February 2019. We will also be following the methodology established by ASCE for the National Report Card, and present the California State's Report Card in simple terms so it can be easily understood and referenced by elected officials and the general public.

#### The Schedule

The Report Card Development includes 3 major tasks, starting on November 1, 2017 and ending on August 30, 2018
