BACKGROUND:

The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), originally formed in 1852 as the "American Society of Civil Engineers and Architects," is the oldest national engineering society in the United States. Recognizing the importance of the Pacific Northwest to the engineering profession, the ASCE held its 44th annual national convention in Seattle in 1912. This convention was so successful that within a year, three Seattle engineers Samuel H. Hedges, Ernest B. Hussey, and Joseph Jacobs founded the Seattle Section of the ASCE on June 30, 1913. Since its founding, the Seattle Section of the ASCE has reflected the development and economic fortunes of the area.

Throughout its history, the Seattle section of the society has been active in serving the welfare of its members and the community. Aside from the promotion of the engineering profession, the Seattle section has been active in the recommendation on the appointment of public officials, especially those involved in construction and engineering. The society's political efforts have also included being involved in relevant legislation concerning the engineering profession and the registration of members. Members of the society have had an impact on public works in Washington State, including the development of Seattle's first harbor, recommending locations for Interstate 5 through Seattle in 1957 and a cross-sound ferry terminal in 1961, and aiding in setting up a 38 million dollar construction program for the City of Seattle as part of the re-employment efforts following World War II.

Aside from promoting civil engineering projects, the section speaks as a unified voice for all civil engineers. The section was at the forefront of the civil rights movement by recognizing and promoting the equal rights and abilities of minorities. Also promoted by the section are awards for outstanding achievement in the engineering profession and a code of ethics to aid members in their pursuit of professional excellence. Aiding engineering students through the student chapters at the University of Washington and Seattle University also promotes the profession to a new generation of engineers. Although these are all important goals of the Seattle section, its most important role is the making available to the public the technical skills to advance projects and proposals for private and public institutions. "The advancement of the science and profession of engineering" has always been the objective of the society as it leads its members into many activities that are in the public interest.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Serving the engineering community of Seattle, the ASCE devoted the majority of its energies on the promotion and problems of the engineering field. Through articles, correspondence, financial records, handbooks, addresses, annual reports, press releases, project files, photographs, pamphlets, newsletters, minutes and agendas, membership lists, reports, and committee files, a picture of the engineering field in Seattle emerges. The majority of records contained in this collection consist of

correspondence and committee files.

Committee files illustrate the section's activities in such areas as legislation, student chapters, disaster preparedness, awards, civil defense, community projects, employment conditions, ethics, education, finances, history of the section, minorities, professional activities and objectives, public relations, natural resources, surveying and mapping, and the annual yearbook. Correspondence in this collection contains the same types of information as the committee files, especially on membership. Membership concerns and education records are illustrated in most of the files.

The historical files portray the members of the Seattle section through biographies, interviews, memoirs, obituaries, and resumes. Many of these records were created after a member died. Historical information is also located in the annual reports, correspondence, meeting minutes, project files, pamphlets, newsletters, and the committee files. All of the records within this collection illustrate the role and importance of civil engineers in society.
