 - Sponsorship of Local or regional competitions (e.g., Popsicle Stick Bridge, LEGO, Future Cities, Science Fairs)
 - Career Day (for High School, Technical School) supplies/displays
 - Sponsor junior high or high school students to attend STEM related summer camps
 - Sponsor High School, Technical School, or early college students to attend ASCE Branch meetings, Regional Conferences, or Branch sponsored tours
- If it is not obvious, please include how the grant will support and enhance Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) education.
