Project of the Year - Last Call for Projects

The Vermont Section of ASCE is proud to announce its third annual Project of the Year Award. To nominate a Project for this award, the Project must have been constructed within the last two years or will be substantially complete by May 2024. The Project of the Year Award will be presented at the VT ASCE Annual Meeting along with the Engineer of the Year Award and Young Engineer of the Year Award. Each Project will be assessed on three criteria:

Grading Criteria (scale of 1-10 points each)

1. Design or construction methodology uses new or innovative technology, techniques, and/or materials.
2. Demonstrates an overall benefit to the local community.
3. Utilizes sustainable engineering practices and resources in a way that does not compromise the environment or deplete natural resources for future generations.

Additional submission requirements:

1. The project must have been constructed or substantially completed between January 2022 and May 2024.
2. At least one member of the design team or construction team must be a member of Vermont ASCE.
3. The Project submission deadline has been extended to **February 16, 2024**. Please reach out to Jordan Duffy ASAP if you are planning to submit a project for consideration.

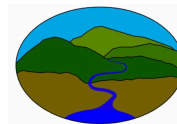
