Project of the Year - Call for Projects

The Vermont Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) is proud to announce its fourth annual Project of the Year Award. To nominate a Project for this award, the Project must have been constructed in the state of Vermont within the last three years or will be substantially complete by the time of submission. The Project of the Year Award will be presented at the VT ASCE Annual Meeting along with the Engineer of the Year Award and Young Engineer of the Year Award. Each Project will be assessed on three criteria:

Grading Criteria (scale of 1-10 points each)

1. Design or construction methodology uses new or innovative technology, techniques, and/or materials

2. Demonstrates an overall benefit to the local community
3. Utilizes sustainable engineering practices and resources in a way that does not compromise the environment or deplete natural resources for future generations

Additional submission requirements:

1. Project must have been constructed or substantially complete between January 2022 and the submission date.
2. At least one member of the design team or construction team must be a member of Vermont ASCE.
3. The Project must have been constructed in the State of Vermont.
4. The Project submission deadline has been extended to **February 14, 2025.**
